The Permian Strategic Partnership (PSP) is a coalition of 27 leading Permian Basin energy companies and higher education institutions. They work in partnership with leaders across the region's communities to address current and future challenges to the responsible development of the vast oil and natural gas resources of the Permian Basin in the states of New Mexico and Texas.

Endeavor has committed to a \$10 million investment to strengthen our Permian Basin community.





FEATURED PROJECTS

HOLDSWORTH CENTER

The Holdsworth Center is an education leadership development center focused on improving the quality of public schools for Texas students.

For the Permian Basin, the Holdsworth team catered their program to rural districts in both West Texas and Southeastern New Mexico and has brought the program to our districts directly, eliminating the need for them to travel out of district for leadership development.

UTPB BEHAVIORAL HEALTH PROFESSIONALS

In collaboration with the University of Texas Permian Basin and the Scharbauer Foundation, the PSP is contributing to an expansion that doubles the capacity and enrollment of the Master's-level program in behavioral health. This expansion is essential for addressing the growing demand for mental health services in Texas, as a Master's degree is required to become a provider in this field. By investing in this program, we're not only strengthening the behavioral health workforce but also ensuring better access to quality care for individuals in our community.

PRINCIPAL INCENTIVE ALLOTMENTS

This opportunity allows school districts to develop a locallydesigned model of strategic compensation for school principals and will mirror the state-funded Teacher Incentive Allotment.

High Sky Children's Ranch is an organization dedicated to healing abused children and promoting family wholeness since 1963. They are a staple in the Midland community and have served more than 37,000 people since they've opened their doors.

More than 200 Endeavor volunteers power washed, organized donations, assembled clothing racks and storage shelves, cleaned the gymnasium and two homes, moved boxes and furniture, detailed three vans, landscaped, painted fascia, washed windows, stained fences, and shampooed training room chairs.


FEEL THE ENERGY FOR **THE CITY** OF **MIDLAND**

Endeavor employees contributed to the construction of two Habitat homes on Bunche Street with Midland Habitat for Humanity.

Our team lent a helping hand and engaged in a variety of tasks, including raising walls and roof trusses, installing siding, windows, and doors, caulking, laying flooring, and general cleanup. We also served in the warehouse, building



walls for future homes, and in the Habitat ReStore, Habitat's secondhand retail store.

While making an impact together, we reinforce the values of teamwork and community service that define our company culture.

Endeavor also donated 21 acres of land to Habitat for Humanity in the Permian Basin. This property is the future home to hundreds of deserving Midlanders with capacity for more than 100 houses.
